What does your liturgy teach?

Have you ever considered what you are teaching your congregation from the weekly liturgy you follow? Liturgy is not a bad word for Baptists. It is not a word that can only be used by High-Church mainline denominations. It is a word that simply means “order.” We all have an order by which we organize our services every Sunday whether we print them in a bulletin or not. So, what kind of order exists for your worship service? Most of us never stop to think through what we do and when we do it. We simply follow the order of things in our services the way they have always been. However, it is worth considering how our order of worship can teach us good habits or bad habits in our relationship with God.

I would suggest that you think for just a minute about what your normal Sunday service order of worship looks like and then ask yourself, “what does this train the congregation to think and prioritize every service?” Does it bring glory to God and focus us on Christ or does it highlight our church activities more? Does it move people along the storyline of Scripture from creation to new creation? Does it draw people into a pattern of worship that helps them connect the dots of guilt, grace, and gratitude? Do our services follow a gospel-redemption arc, which includes corporate confession of sin? As we plan our services we must remember that the church’s worship patterns will serve the gathered congregation as they proclaim the gospel. We will reinforce a weekly habit of how a believer should approach God in worship. So, it is worth contemplation over how you are making disciple-making disciples to see South Mississippi become known for the name of Jesus Christ, Bro. T

As we start this new year, I want to remind you of the ongoing shortage of pastors the SBC in general is facing. Retiring pastors, hurt pastors leaving ministry, the failure of the church to raise up new pastors, and the failure of the church to call out the newly called. We could spend a whole day blaming it on a myriad of factors but in the end the reality of the looming crisis will still be in front of us. We should take the time to think through the "why" of the crisis so we will be better informed for the future and so we will not repeat the mistakes of the past. But, at this moment I just want to challenge you to start praying to the Lord of the Harvest to raise-up workers for the harvest. Specifically we need to ask Him for men called to pastor churches.

And He said to them, The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest....”
